

Important Homework Information

Primary 1-3



Weekly instructions will be posted on Seesaw each Monday. All responses to homework should be uploaded to Seesaw by a Thursday evening.

All activities should be carried out at home and evidence sent back to the class teacher via Seesaw if and when required. Practical and written activities can be photographed and the pictures uploaded as evidence.

Worksheets will often be uploaded and these will need to be printed as at this young age pencil skills are so important. If you have any trouble with printing documents, please inform your teacher (tablets/phones will require a wireless printer). We would ask that letter formation and sentence writing is not carried out on touch screen devices, pencil and paper are essential.

Sometimes activities may be able to be completed on devices, teachers will make this clear on the instruction sheet.

Practical items such as playdoh/counters/number lines etc will be sent home at various stages throughout the year. These items **MUST** be kept safe as they will be needed at different times throughout the year.

Daily reading will continue as normal in school (P2/3 initially). Both books covered in class will be sent home on the following Monday and kept at home all week to be read and re-read each night.
