Car Park

Please show extreme caution when using the school car park at drop-off and collection times. We ask that parents drop their child off at the drop-off/pick-up point (at the foot of the path leading to school) and leave the car park in a clockwise direction. If you are walking your child to their class (P1 parents), please park in a parking space before doing so. At collection times, please make sure to park your car in a parking space and stand at your door so that staff can see you and send your child to your car via the footpaths. If you are parked in the middle spaces, please walk to the drop-off/pick-up point to meet your child and walk them safely back to your vehicle. Please follow the clockwise direction for entering and leaving and be mindful of other traffic and children entering / exiting cars when driving. If the car park is very busy, you can also use the Chapel car park and walk to the drop-off/pick-up point to collect your child.

Education Minister's Visit

The Education Minister will visit the school next Wednesday. We will be putting forward a number of arguments to have our current school enrolment number revised to an acceptable number which will allow us to cater for our growing community. Our official school enrolment number sits at 83 yet we currently have 158 children in the school. An increase to the official enrolment number would lead to the provision of new accommodation such as toilets and classroom space which is very much needed.
