Upcoming Strike Action

As you may be aware, a number of Trade Unions including the (INTO) Irish National Teachers Organisation will be taking part in a half-day of industrial action next Wednesday 29th November. Teaching staff who are members of these trade unions will be unavailable for work until 12 noon on this date.

As a result of this action, school will not open until 12 noon next Wednesday 29th November.

Children who cannot attend school on that day will be marked in on the register using an appropriate code that will mean it is not counted as an unauthorised absence.

School meals will be available for children who are entitled to free school meals only, others will require a packed lunch.

Hign-5 Friday

High-5 Friday will take place next Friday 1st December. This is a whole school emotional health and wellbeing programme based on the 'Take 5 steps to Wellbeing' (Connect / Be Active / Take Notice / Keep Learning / Give) EA initiative. Children will have a fun and relaxed day to support their emotional health and well-being. There will be no testing and children can wear their own clothes (children can take in £1 towards school funds on this day).

Pantomime

All children will attend 'Aladdin' in the Market Place Theatre on Tuesday 5th December at 1.00pm.
